



HOW DO I FIND INFORMATION ON COVID-19?

Go to bass.lsr7.org and click on the "COVID-19" tab. You will find the most up to date information regarding new procedures and other updated changes following national, state, local and health department and education officials.



HOW DO WE GET EMERGENCY COMMUNICATION OR CHANGES?

Communication is very important. Texts and phone calls will be sent through EZ Child Track. Important and critical communication is posted on our website and/or is sent through email. Emails are generally sent to the primary account holder only.

WHAT ARE THE DATES I CAN ENROLL ONLINE?

Enrollment for Fall and Summer open in spring each year. Information is on the BASS website under the "Rates & Info" tab. Enrollment in BASS is first come first served. Waitlists will be utilized. Enrollment for BASS programs will be CLOSED August 24-31.



HOW DO I ENROLL FOR NON-SCHOOL DAYS?

Non-School Days are not included in your regular tuition. Families will no longer need to enroll or de-enroll their children in the Non-School Day program and there will be no enrollment deadline dates. Families will not pay the \$25 Non-School Day fee unless their child actually checks in/out on a non-school day. Once the Site Coordinator submits attendance for that day, the fee will be posted to the account. Families will pay for the Non-School Days after attendance.

*Early Release Days are included with tuition and do not require a registration.

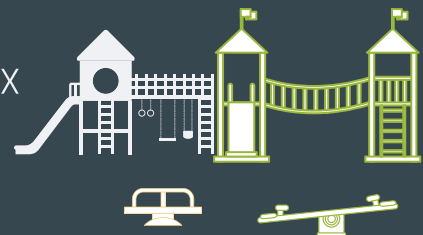


WHICH COMBO SITE WILL MY CHILD ATTEND ON A NON-SCHOOL DAY?

Non-School combo days (including Spring Break) are at 7 locations.

- CCE:** Cedar Creek & Pleasant Lea
- LFE:** Longview Farm & Hawthorn Hill
- PVE:** Prairie View, Lee's Summit, Westview & 3LYNX
- RHE:** Richardson, Highland Park & Mason
- SPE:** Summit Pointe & Trailridge
- SVE:** Sunset Valley, Greenwood & Woodland
- UWE:** Underwood, Meadow Lane & Hazel Grove

*If there are extreme winter conditions UWE would be the only location open.



DO YOU ALLOW STATUS CHANGES THROUGHOUT THE SCHOOL YEAR?

All changes in status, including dropping from the program, must occur prior to the 25th of the month by contacting the BASS Admin Office at 986-3440. All changes will be effective the first day of the following month. Families are encouraged to limit their changes in status to no more than once per semester.



HOW DO I PAY BASS TUITION?

Each month has a different tuition rate based on the number of days within that month. Payments are due on the 1st, late after the 15th. If an outstanding balance is not paid in full by midnight on the 15th day of the month, there will be a \$40 late payment fee added to your account. Payments can be made the following ways:

- Pay online (credit card or e-check) at bass.lsr7.org, "Make a payment." E-check is a free online option for you, credit or debit cards have a \$10 processing fee.
- Money orders and cash can be dropped off in person at the BASS Office at 1151 NE Colbern Rd, LS MO 64086. BASS has a drop box open 24 hrs. a day, located on the east side of the BASS office for checks and money orders.

DO YOU OFFER FEE ASSISTANCE?

Fee Assistance is available to qualifying families and is generally contingent on Free or Reduced Lunch status. Limited funds are available. The application process is available on our website at bass.lsr7.org under the Rates & Info tab or by calling our office. Annual application for Fee Assistance is required. BASS is not a registered provider with the state and does not receive subsidy.



HOW DO I GET MY TAX STATEMENT?

Primary account holders can log into the EZ Child Track parent portal online to access tax statements, receipts, invoices, important documents, and more. Go to bass.lsr7.org and click "View my account." Once you are logged into your account, click on View Statement under "Payments & Statements." Then click on "Print" under Tax Statements on the far right.



DOES BASS OFFER SUMMER CARE?

BASS offers care before and after Summer Learning in June, full days on Fridays and full day care in July and August. BASS will operate at District-determined sites during the summer. The summer program requires a separate enrollment and begins in the Spring. All students who attend in June must be enrolled in the Summer Learning Program. In the event a program reaches maximum capacity, a wait list will be maintained. Fun field trips, curriculum and activities are planned throughout the summer.



WHO IS WATCHING MY CHILDREN AT BASS?

Each site is led by a Site Coordinator (and Assistant at some locations) and supported by associates at a minimum of 1:15 staff to child ratio. Staff are LSR7 district employees receiving background checks and other required trainings.



HOW DO I CHANGE OR ADD INFORMATION TO MY CHILD'S ENROLLMENT/ACCOUNT?

To change or add authorized persons to pick up your child or add PINs for each person to pick up your child, you can log into the EZ Child Track parent portal. Click on "My Account" in the top right corner and then change profile information for each person. If you need something else changed within your profile, please contact the BASS Admin Office at 986-3440.

WHAT DO KIDS DO IN THE PROGRAM?

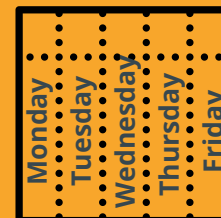
Here are some of the activities planned throughout the year at BASS:

CAN MY CHILD ATTEND 2 OR 3 DAYS A WEEK?

BASS does not have a part-time or drop-in option for care. Fees are not reduced for part time care. You must pay for 5 days a week, Before & After or Before Only or After Only. If your child is not planning to attend every day, you must have good communication with the Site Coordinator to let them know when to expect your child for safety reasons.

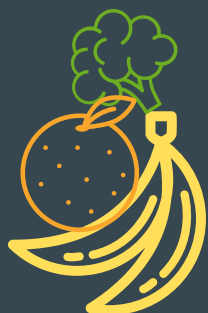


DOES BASS PROVIDE SNACKS?

Snacks are offered to all children in the after school program and preschool programs.

Breakfast is available for purchase at each elementary school on regular school days. You may place payment in your nutrition account for your child's breakfast just as you may for lunch. You may also send snacks from home to enjoy during designated snack time. Per Board of Education Policy, food is not to be brought in by individual children to share with others.

On Non-School Days, each child must bring a sack lunch. In the event your child forgets his/her lunch, a non-perishable lunch will be provided at a charge of \$5.00.



WHAT IS SUMMITRISE?

SummitRise is a structured student supervision program available on late-start Wednesday mornings to families with elementary-age children at no additional cost and no registration. SummitRise begins 30 minutes before the school's regular start time. SummitRise will be available on all Wednesdays throughout the school year with the exception of the 1st day of school and any Early Release Days that fall on Wednesdays. If your child has an early school SummitRise starts at 7:50 a.m. and if your child attends a late school SummitRise starts at 8:30 a.m.



WHAT ARE YOUR HOURS?

We open at 6:30 a.m. until school start time and school end time until 6:00 p.m.

Non-School Day hours are 6:30 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. at the combo locations.

2-Hour Delayed Start hours are 6:30 a.m. - school start. (Does not include 3LYNX)

Snow Day hours are 7:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. at the combo locations.



NEW BASS CLOSED DATE

For the 2020-21 School Year, BASS will be closed November 3rd for a Staff Professional Workday on Equity, Inclusion and Safety.



IS THERE TRANSPORTATION FROM THE SCHOOL TO THE LOCATION?

BASS currently has a program in each elementary school so students stay in the same location all day and transportation is not required.

During Summer Camp and some Non-School Days, there are field trips scheduled. Children should arrive at least 30 minutes prior to departure on a field trip day. Everyone attending the day of the field trip, will be expected to go on the trip with the entire group. Staff will not remain at the school during field trips.



WHERE DO I GO TO DROP OFF AND PICK UP?

We have a designated door with a Kids Country entrance sign. Kids Country staff will be available to answer questions at Meet the Teacher night. If visiting mid-school year, please contact the Site Coordinator.

DO YOU PROVIDE HOMEWORK HELP?

BASS staff may be available to assist children in this area as time and ratios allow. A+ students are also available at times and may assist children with homework. BASS will do all it can to assist a child with his/her homework but must receive cooperation from the child in order to do so. In the event the child is not cooperative, homework may not be completed that day. BASS also allows the parents a preference regarding how they would like homework handled for their children, options are listed in the enrollment process.
