<u>SummitRise</u>

SummitRise is the no-cost structured student supervision program available on late-start days to families with elementary-age children. SummitRise begins 30 minutes before the school's <u>regular</u> start time.

Families already enrolled in Kids Country for morning care will participate in SummitRise and see no increase in fees as a result of the late-start day. Additionally, any child in the school may attend the SummitRise program at no additional fee. The chart below provides specific SummitRise schedules. SummitRise General Schedule

Students are dropped off at the designated entrance – typically the front door of the school. Students enter the building to check in and go to the BASS cafeteria/ homeroom.

While at SummitRise, children will be able to do the following things:

- → Visit with friends
- → Reading
- → Breakfast
- → Activities may vary according to enrollment/staff

Students will remain in the cafeteria/homeroom until SummitRise dismissal to class.
